

Peer-Voted Song of the Year Terms & Conditions

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of these conditions of entry. Entry into the 2026 APRA Peer-Voted Song of the Year Promotion is deemed to be an acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. Promotion commences Thursday 13 November 2025 and entries close at midday ADST on Thursday 22 January 2026.
3. You need to be an APRA AMCOS member currently living in Australia to vote. Or you can be an APRA AMCOS member living overseas with Australian citizenship.
4. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, or agencies, suppliers or companies associated with this Promotion, who are not eligible APRA AMCOS members, are ineligible to enter.
5. For a chance to win, eligible APRA AMCOS members must vote for the APRA Peer-Voted Song of the Year by logging onto the secure Members' section of the APRA AMCOS website at www.apraamcos.com.au - you will be prompted to vote once logged in.
6. Limit of one entry per eligible APRA AMCOS member.
